OFFLINE ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Integrated M.Sc. Programme – Academic Year 2025–2026

The offline admission process for the Five-Year Integrated M.Sc. Programme will be conducted as per the following details. Candidates are requested to read the instructions carefully and adhere strictly to the timelines and requirements.

Day and Date – Monday, July 28, 2025

Reporting Time: 8:30 AM - 10:00 AM

Important: Only those candidates who report on or before 10:00 AM will be considered for admission. Upon arrival at the venue, the candidate must fill the onsite registration form and hand it over to CEBS officials.

Documents required during Offline Admission Process on 28.07.2025:

- 1) Original Migration Certificate of Class XII (to be submitted to the University of Mumbai upon completion of the admission process)
- 2) School Leaving / College Leaving Certificate
- 3) Photocopies of Class X and Class XII Marksheet and Passing Certificate
- 4) Proof of Date of Birth (applicable only if DoB is not mentioned in any of the documents above).
- 5) NEST 2025 score card
- 6) Proof of Citizenship - OCI card (applicable only if born outside India)
- 7) Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- 8) Valid Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (in case of OBC candidates – if applicable)

- 9) Valid EWS certificate (in case of EWS candidates – if applicable)
- 10) If category certificate is not in either English or Hindi, then a translated version in English or Hindi must also be provided.
- 11) Students applying under the J&K/Ladakh quota should have the J&K/Ladakh Domicile certificate and must have passed their class XII examination from State Board or CBSE affiliated school located in J&K/Ladakh.
- 12) If applicable, disability certificate from Govt/Municipal Hospital showing 40% and above impairment. Candidates are advised to ensure that the certificate is in accordance with the latest guidelines of the Government of India.
- 13) Anti-ragging affidavits (i) by the student, and (ii) by the parent/guardian, each on Rs. 500/- non-judicial stamp paper. Please note that both of these must be notarized.
- 14) Undertaking form duly signed by student and parent/guardian.
- 15) 4 passport size photographs

Note: During the admission process, all original documents/certificates must be submitted for verification. Self-attested Photocopies will be retained, and all original documents will be returned after verification, except for the Migration Certificate.

Fees structure for Integrated M.Sc. Programme for Academic Year 2025-2026

- A one-time payment of Rs. 8,000/- will be collected at the time of admission, which includes a refundable deposit of Rs. 6,000/-.
- General / OBC = Rs. 7,300/- for one semester
- SC/ST = Rs. 3,300/- for one semester

Total fees to be paid by students payable at the time of admission:

- General / OBC = Rs. 15,300/-
- SC/ST = Rs. 11,300/-
- PwD candidates shall pay the fees of their respective category.

Note: Mess fees (to be paid at the time of joining), Medical Insurance fees, University Eligibility and Enrollment fees, and Convocation fees shall be charged as per actuals and are not subject to any concession.

Mode of payment of fees:

Online payment (preferred) – The payment link will be generated at the time of admission
Cheque / DD – to be drawn in favour of UM-DAE CBS
