SECTION 2 – ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

CATEGORY

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR HIGH-PURITY GASES

1. This Invitation for Bids is open to all Original Manufacturers/ their Authorized Dealers/vendors/suppliers to quote on their behalf for this tender as per the Manufacturer's Authorization Form, and who possess the qualifying requirements as specified in the Tender document. **Please refer to Annexure-1**
2. Bidders Information. **Please refer to Annexure 2**
3. The Bidder should have the existence of the firm for a minimum period of 3 Years (Certificate of Incorporation/Registration Certificate of the firm) **Please refer to Annexure-3**
4. Copy of the PAN card of the firm.
5. The Bidder should have a Gas chromatograph, Moisture Analyser, Oxygen Analyser, Hydro-Carbon Analyser etc. machines in order to analyse the purity of gases. (List and details of machinery to be enclosed mandatory). **The committee may visit the eligible qualified bidder's company for inspection. The bidder can be disqualified if the committee finds their machines are improper for analysing the purity of gases.**
6. The Bidder must **not be blacklisted/Suspended/debarred** or any service-related dispute with any organisation/Govt. Organisations/banks in India or outside India or any litigation pending. **Please refer to Annexure A-4.**
7. **Experience** – The bidders should have experience in the execution of orders to any High Educational Research Institute or Govt. organisations for similar items. Copies of such order must be enclosed with the offer.- **Annexure-5**
8. **Valid Explosive Licenses:** The bidder must have a Valid Explosive License certificate for all the Industrial Gases on the Rate contract for manufacturing and storing till safe delivery of industrial gases.
9. **Local Content Certificate:** - CEBS intends to give product reservation to local suppliers in line with current procurement policies of Govt. of India. For the above purpose, local supplier means a supplier or service provider whose product or service offered for procurement meets the minimum local content as prescribed in "Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) order 2017 of GOI, Dept. of DIPP" (OM No. P-45021 12/2017-PP (BE-II) dated 04th June, 2020. Also, Supplier should have his head/regional office in Mumbai/ Mumbai suburban/ Navi Mumbai/ Thane region.
Necessary certification for local content must be submitted by the prospective bidders strictly as per attached annexure with the tender document. **Please refer Annexure-**



SECTION 3

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

A) SUBMISSION OF OFFER:

1. The tender should be dropped in the tender box kept in CEBS Main gate tender is to be handed over to our staff personally unless otherwise specified.
2. The quotation shall be submitted in a sealed envelope duly superscribed with the tender enquiry number, and the due date in bold letters, addressed to the UM-DAE Centre for Excellence in Basic Sciences, Nalanda Building, Gr. Flr. University of Mumbai, Vidyanagari, Mumbai 400098. The envelopes should be marked on top as the Tender Enquiry No., Due Date in bold letters. The sealed envelope has to be delivered by hand/courier on or before the due date specified. Tenders submitted after the last date will not be considered. In case the quotation is not sealed in the envelope the tender will be rejected.
3. The tender must be submitted in one-stage bidding.
4. **Bidders should quote for all the items of the tender document.**
5. **Bidders have to mention impurities of gases in their bid document. The committee will finalize the impurities submitted by all bidders in their bid document.**
6. Quoting of Price (s) : Price quoted should be in Indian Rupees, with free pick up & delivery at UM-DAE Centre for Excellence in Basic Sciences, Nalanda Building, University of Mumbai, Vidyanagari, Mumbai 400098, India.
Prices must be inclusive of transportation cost and other charges.
7. Any bidder currently engaged in litigation with other Organizations, must inform their status in writing.
8. Communication with bidders will be carried out electronically and /or in hard copy. All bidders must provide their current E-mail address.

B) COST OF BIDDING :

1. The Bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its Bid and the Purchaser shall not be responsible or liable for those costs.

C) VALIDITY OF THE BID : 180 Days from the date of submission of bid.

D) AMENDMENT OF BIDDING DOCUMENTS :

1. At any time before the deadline for submission of bids, CEBS, Mumbai may for any reason, whether on its own or in response to the clarification request by a prospective BIDDER may modify the bid document.
2. All prospective BIDDER's who have downloaded the bidding document may visit CEBS, Mumbai website (cbs.ac.in) for amendments / modifications which will be binding on them.



E) DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF BIDS :

1. Bids must be received by CEBS, Mumbai, before the due date and time at the address specified in the tender document

F) BID OPENING PROCESS:

1. In one stage bidding system, the bids will be opened in the presence of representatives of the bidders at CEBS, Nalanda Building, University of Mumbai, Vidyanagari, Mumbai 400098, India.
2. One authorized representative of each of the bidders would be permitted to be present at the time of the aforementioned opening of the bids.
3. The authorized representative of bidders, present at the time of opening of the bids shall be required to sign an attendance register as proof of having attended the commercial bid opening.

G) LATE BIDS :

1. CEBS -Mumbai will not be responsible:
 - (a) For delayed / late quotations submitted / sent by post / courier etc.
 - (b) For submission / delivery of quotations at wrong places other than the mentioned in the tender.
 - (c) Any bid inadvertently received by CEBS Mumbai after the deadline i.e. due date & time for submission of bids, will not be accepted and returned.

H) SUPPLEMENTARY OFFER /MODIFICATION OF ORIGINAL BID:

1. Tender submitted against Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) shall not be returned in case the tender opening date is extended/postponed. BIDDER desirous to modify their offer/terms may submit their revised / supplementary offer (s) within the extended Tender Opening Date (TOD) by clearly stating to the extent of updation done to the original bid. The purchaser reserves the right to open the original offer along with the revised bid.

I) CONFIDENTIALITY :

1. Information relating to the evaluation of Bids, and recommendation of Contract award, shall not be disclosed to Bidders or any other persons not officially concerned with such process until information on Contract award is communicated to all Bidders.
2. Any attempt by a Bidder to influence the Purchaser in the evaluation of the Bids or Contract award decisions may result in the rejection of its Bid.
3. Notwithstanding, from the time of Bid opening to the time of Contract award, if any Bidder wishes to contact the Purchaser on any matter related to the bidding process, it shall do so in writing.

J) DEVIATION, RESERVATIONS AND OMISSIONS:

1. During the evaluation of Bids, the following definitions apply:
 - (a) "Deviation" is a departure from the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents;
 - (b) "Reservation" is the setting of limiting conditions or withholding from complete acceptance of the requirements specified in the Bidding Documents;and
 - (c) "Omission" is the failure to submit part or all of the information or documentation required in the Bidding Documents.



K) CORRECTION OF ARITHMETICAL ERRORS:

1. Provided that the Bid is substantially responsive, the Purchaser shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:

(a) if there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the line item total that is obtained by multiplying the unit price by the quantity, the unit price shall

(b) prevail and the line item total shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the Purchaser there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the line item total as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected;

(c) if there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; and

(d) if there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (a) and (b) above.

2. Bidders shall be requested to accept the correction of arithmetical errors. Failure to accept the correction by the same shall result in the rejection of the Bid.

L) EVALUATION OF BID :

1. CEBS Mumbai will evaluate the bid offers on a landed net Price basis.
2. Offer which deviates from the vital conditions (as illustrated below) of the tender shall be rejected:
 - a) Non- submission of complete offers.
 - b) Receipt of offers after the due date and time and or by email/fax (unless specified otherwise).
 - c) Receipt of offers in open conditions.
3. In case any BIDDER is silent on any clauses mentioned in this tender document, CEBS, Mumbai shall construe that the BIDDER had accepted the clauses as per the invitation to tender no further claim will be entertained.
4. No revision in the terms and conditions quoted in the offer will be entertained after the last date and time fixed for receipt of tenders.
5. **The tender will be taken as inclusive of all Taxes if nothing is stated by the firm.**
6. If the supplier wish to give pricing details it may be attached in a separate sheet.
7. In case of Multiple options of same product, bidders are requested to quote only one best option and not multiple options.
8. The quantity mentioned in the tender can be increased or decreased to any extent depending upon the actual requirement.

M) CORRUPT & FRAUDULENT PRACTICES:

1. CEBS Mumbai requires that bidders, suppliers, contractors and consultants, if any, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. In pursuit of this policy,

(a) The terms set forth below are defined as follows:

- “Corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting, directly or indirectly, of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution;
- “Fraudulent practice” means a misrepresentation or omission of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract;
- “Collusive practice” means a scheme or arrangement between two or more bidders, designed to establish bid prices at artificial, non- competitive levels; and



- “Coercive practice” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the procurement process or affect the execution of a contract;

(b) CEBS Mumbai will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Bidder recommended for award has, directly or through an agent, engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for the Contract in question.

N) TRANSFER AND SUBLETTING :

1. The seller shall not sublet, transfer, assign or otherwise part with the acceptance to the tender or any part thereof, either directly or indirectly, without the prior written permission of the Purchaser.

O) CANCELLATION OF TENDER :

1. Notwithstanding anything specified in this tender document, CEBS Mumbai in his sole discretion, unconditionally and without assigning any reasons, reserves the rights:
 - a) To accept OR reject lowest tender or any other tender or all the tenders.
 - b) To accept any tender in full or in part.
 - c) To reject the tender offer not confirming to the tenders terms.
2. To give purchase preference to Public Sector undertakings when applicable as per Govt. Policy/ Guidelines.
3. Offer which deviates from the vital conditions (as illustrates below) of the tender shall be rejected:
 - a) Non-submission of complete offers.
 - b) Receipt of offers after the due date and time and or by email/fax (unless specified otherwise).
 - c) Receipt of offers in open conditions.
4. Conditional Tenders and Unsigned Tenders will also be rejected.
5. If the quality of the product and service provided is not found satisfactory, CEBS Mumbai reserves the right to cancel or amend the contract.

P) DELIVERY :

SECTION 4 – TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A) AWARD OF CONTRACT :

1. **The Rate Contract will be awarded to the technically qualified L1 bidder** based on the total value of all the line items. The L2 bidder will be allowed to match L1 rates and if L2 does not agree to match L1 then the L3 bidder will be allowed to match L1.
2. Further, CEBS reserves the right to bring multiple parties under the rate contract subject to their matching of the rates with that of the L1 bidder.
3. The Empaneled suppliers will abide by all the Terms & Conditions of the Tender Document.
4. The Performance of the empanelled suppliers will be reviewed by the committee during the contract period and CEBS, Mumbai reserves the right to add or delete suppliers in the rate contract based on performance, if necessary, without intimation.
5. **Initially the contract will be awarded for one year thereafter, the contract may be extended for two years subject to annual revision, if their performance is found satisfactory.**
6. The tendering firms must confirm in their tender that it will be their responsibility to possess valid Explosive Licenses for all Industrial Gases on the Rate contract for manufacturing and storing till safe delivery of industrial gases to the CEBS, Mumbai entire operation of the rate contract.
7. Manufacturer's Test Certificate and Purity Certificate are to be submitted along with every supply.
8. Transit Insurance Clause: The purchaser will not pay separately for transit insurance and the supplier will be responsible till the entire stores contracted for, arrive in good condition at the destination. The transit risk in this respect may be covered by the supplier by getting the stores duly insured if he so desires. The supplier in his name and not in the name of the consignee shall obtain the insurance cover.
9. The supplier has to supply cylinder as per requirement.
10. The Service Provider should have Service Centre in Mumbai District or Mumbai Suburban District or Navi Mumbai for more than three years till the date of submission of Bid, the address proof for Location of Service Centre should be provided.

B) EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

1. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 7,000/- (Rs. Seven Thousand Only) in the form of Demand Draft in the favour of **UM-DAE CBS** payable at Mumbai to be submitted in the Bid. Failing which, the submitted bid will be Rejected.
2. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned within 30 days after the award of the contract.
3. EMD of a tenderer will be forfeited, if the tenderer withdraws or amends its tender or derogates from the tender in any respect within the period of validity of its tender. Further, if the successful tenderer fails to furnish the required performance security within the specified period, its EMD will be forfeited.
4. In case there is loss or damage to the material or unsatisfactory services provided to CEBS, Mumbai by the bidder then such losses will be adjusted from the Security deposit.

C) Performance Bank Guarantee:

Successful bidders will have to submit **Security Deposit @ 5% of the contract value** within 15 days from the date of placement of order in the form of Bank Guarantee. The PBG will be valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of contractual obligations. The security amount will be forfeited if the Firm / Supplier fail to perform as per the terms & conditions of our Tender enquiry / document.



D) Payment Terms:

100% Payment will be made within 30 days from the date of submission of the bill for the supplied gas.

E) Standing order and withdrawal:

The CEBS, Mumbai will issue a Standing order for the entire period of the rate contract mentioning the required quantity. The delivery of refilled cylinders should be as per the Stores department instructions/requisition.

F) PENALTY :

Supplier should provide Purity Certificate for each cylinder and if gas cylinder not found comply with the certificate then actual damage will be recovered as penalty.

Timely delivery is the essence of the contract and hence if any consignment is delayed then liquidated damages at the rate of 0.5% of the price of the delayed consignment, for each week or part whereof shall be levied and recovered subject to a maximum of 5% of total purchase order value.

G) FORCE MAJEURE: Force Majeure will be accepted on adequate proof thereof.

H) LEGAL MATTER: Jurisdiction of Mumbai Courts only. In the event of any dispute over this contract, CEBS, Mumbai's decision shall be final and binding.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The Bidder must supply all the items listed in the Category.
2. The vendors will collect the empty cylinders and deliver the refilled cylinders to CEBS, Mumbai Central Stores department without any extra charges.
In the event of any dispute over this contract, CEBS, Mumbai's decision shall be final and binding.
