Bio: Dr. Sudeep Gupta is the Director of the Tata Memorial Centre (TMC) and an internationally renowned medical oncologist specializing in breast and gynecological cancers. He earned his MBBS, MD, and DM degrees from the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, completing his training in 2000. Since June 2001, he has been a faculty member in the Department of Medical Oncology at TMC. A prolific clinical researcher, Dr. Gupta has served as Principal Investigator or Co-investigator in more than 120 Phase I, II, and III clinical trials. His research interests span breast and gynecological cancers, clinical genomics, implementation science, access to medications, guideline development, innovative therapeutic strategies, toxicity and quality-of-life studies, pharmacokinetics, and translational studies involving next-generation sequencing technology. Dr. Gupta has published over 380 papers in peer-reviewed journals and is widely recognized for his contributions to oncology research and practice. In 2025, he was elected Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, India. He is also an active member of several national and international committees and taskforces, including those of DBT, DST, DAE, ICMR, NITI, ESMO, and others.
